Context:

In the frame of the activities of the IOM program “Mosul Emergency Response and Preparedness”, under the overall supervision of the Psychosocial Support and Social Cohesion Unit’s Program Coordinator, the direct supervision of the Psychosocial Officer, the successful candidate will be responsible to:

1. Facilitate assessment of MHPSS needs in designated communities;
2. Conduct non formal education sessions to displaced children and youths in camps and host communities;
3. Organize recreational and supportive activities in the camps and communities;
4. Identify and support existing socializing, recreational and ritual activities within the communities;
5. Develop awareness messages related to psychosocial support (psychological wellbeing, conflict management, cultural awareness) and health promotion (hygiene, prevention, compliance with treatments) to be disseminated to the affected population;
6. Provide psychosocial first aid to the affected population in case of sudden/on-going emergency;
7. Identify cases that require intervention on the psychological level and refer them to the team’s psychologist;
8. Train focal points/volunteers in camps and communities on psychosocial support related issues;
9. Organize support groups and forums for the affected population in camps and host communities;
10. Report on the activities/sessions conducted to the Psychosocial Officer and National Psychosocial Coordinator;
11. Map the existing needs of the affected populations;
12. Any other duty as may be assigned by the Program Manager or Project Officer.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Bachelor’s Degree in Education.
- Post-graduate studies in Education and/or Psychosocial Support in emergency settings is an advantage.
- Previous experiences in educational and protection activities in related Governments of intervention is an advantage.
- Experience in communicating and working with a wide range of people including people of culturally diverse backgrounds.

- good communication, interpersonal and organizational skills;
- ability to draft clearly and concisely;
- demonstrated gender awareness and gender sensitivity;
- ability to work effectively and harmoniously with colleagues from varied cultures and professional backgrounds;
